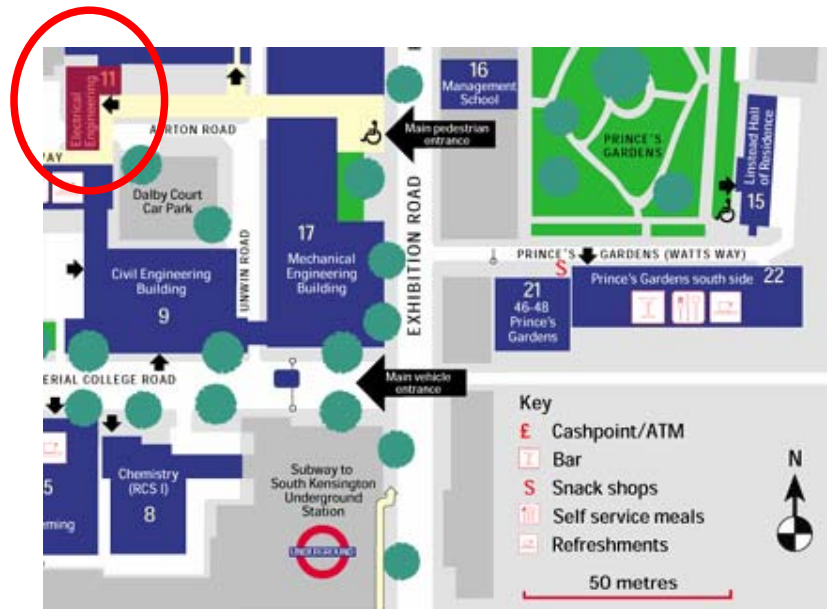

Getting there by Underground

The nearest station is South Kensington

1. At South Kensington Station turn right into the subway sign-posted for the museums
2. Walk past the Science Museum Shop and continue for 5 minutes until you reach the very end of the Subway
3. At the exit turn left up Exhibition Road and walk for 1 minute. You will now be at the main entrance to the South Kensington campus (ultra-modern glass and steel building)
4. Cross the lobby of the main building and enter the courtyard on the backside. The Electrical Engineering Building (#11) is at the far end of the courtyard.
